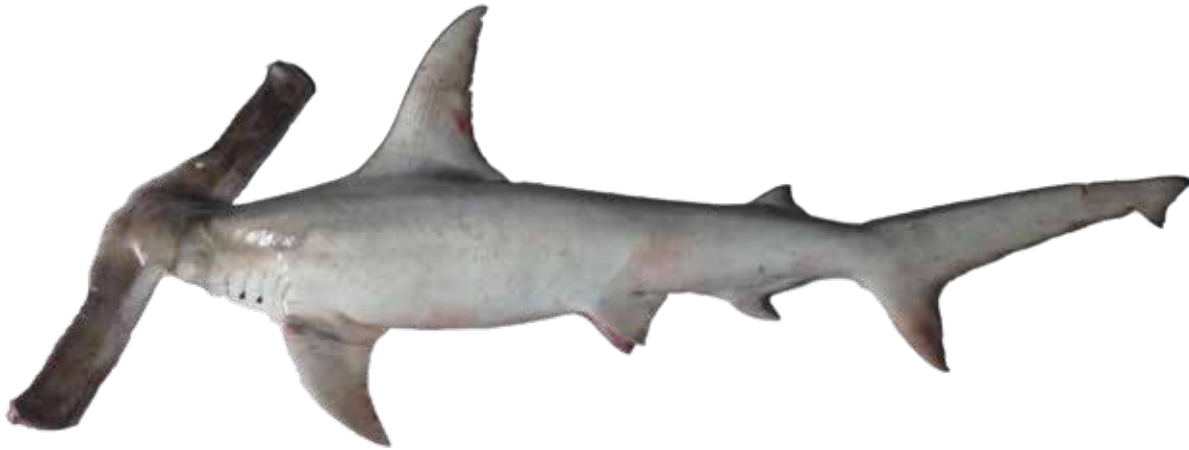

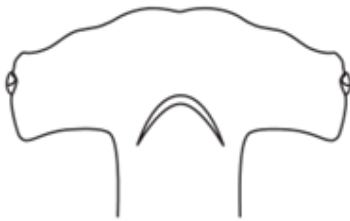

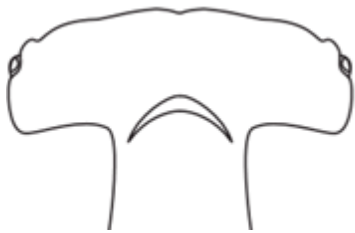


Scalloped Hammerhead



- First dorsal fin moderately tall, second dorsal fin small.
- Olive, bronze or brownish-grey on top, pale underneath.
- Dusky-tipped fins, usually present in juveniles.
- Size: From 45-50cm at birth to 350cm when fully grown.

Great Hammerhead



- Very large dorsal fin, relatively large second dorsal fin.
- Bronze to greyish-brown on top, white underneath.
- Dusky-tipped fins, usually present in juveniles.
- Size: From 65cm at birth to 6m when fully grown.

Winghead Shark



- Tall dorsal fin, with second dorsal fin predominantly small.
- Grey to greyish-brown on top, pale underneath.
- Size: From 45-47cm at birth to 190cm when fully grown.
