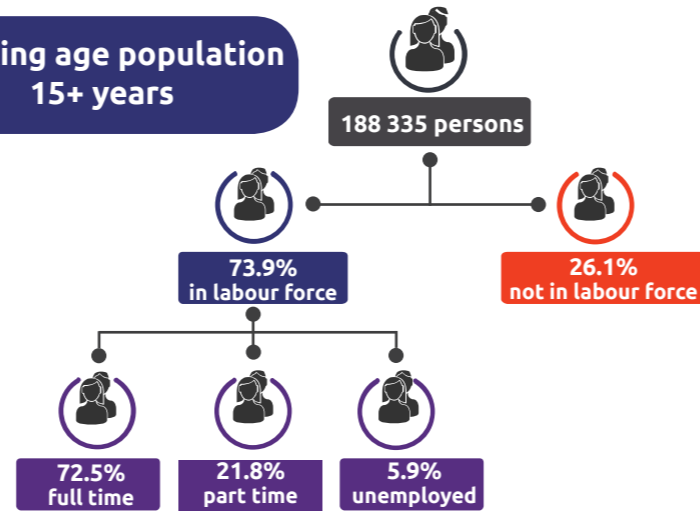

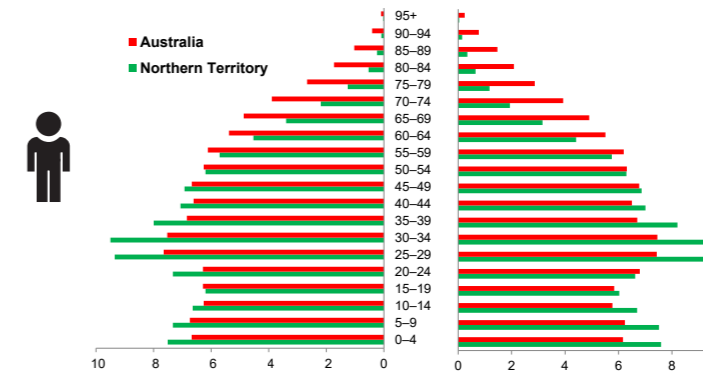

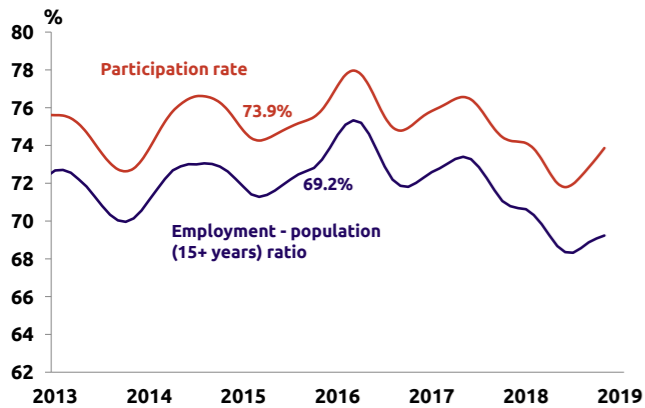

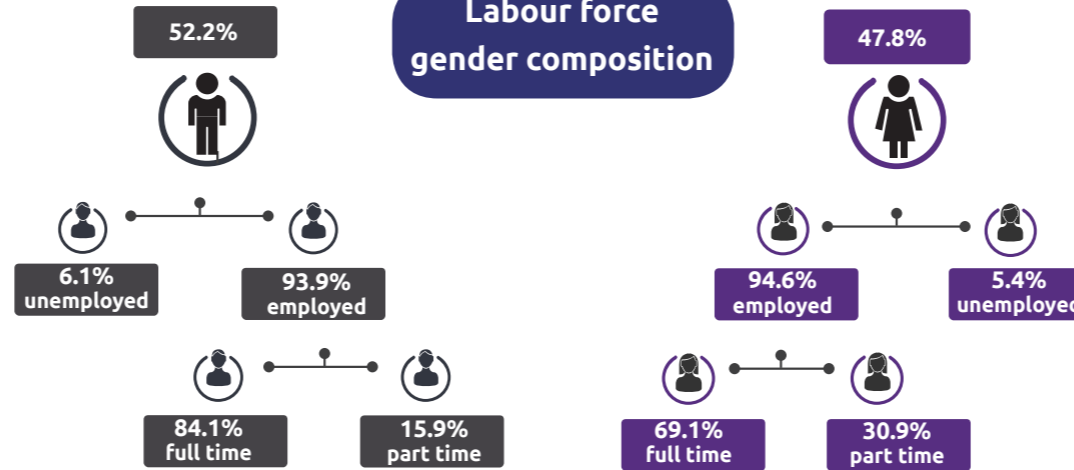


Employment and participation rates

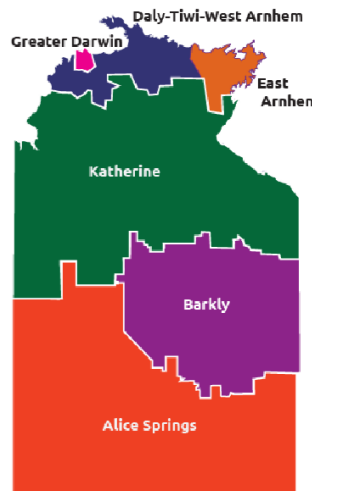
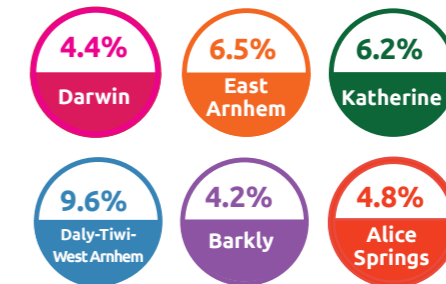


NT Aboriginal participation rate (2014-15) 47%
