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Wholesale Alcohol Supply

Wholesalers registered to trade alcohol in the Northern Territory provide the Department of the Attorney-General and Justice with data on the volume of alcohol supplied to licensed retailers by product type (cask wine, bottled wine, fortified wine, cider, standard spirits, pre-mixed spirits, full-strength beer, mid-strength beer and low-strength beer).

The volume of each product supplied in the Northern Territory is multiplied by its estimated fraction of alcohol content so that the amount of pure alcohol associated with each product type can be compared. The figures presented in this document represent the wholesale supply in litres of Pure Alcohol Content (PAC). Wholesale PAC supply statistics are presented for the Northern Territory as a whole; each of the major urban centres (Darwin, Palmerston, Alice Springs, Katherine, Tennant Creek and Nhulunbuy) and for the Northern Territory Balance¹.

An estimate of the apparent per capita consumption of alcohol in the Northern Territory is determined by dividing the total alcohol supplied in the Northern Territory by an estimate of the population likely to be drinking. National statistics include those people aged 15 years and above as the likely drinking population. As the Northern Territory is a major centre for tourism, the total population likely to be drinking is derived by adding the estimates of the Northern Territory interstate and international tourist numbers² to the Australian Bureau of Statistics' estimates³ of the Northern Territory population aged 15 years and over. Apparent consumption can only be reliably calculated for the whole of the Northern Territory as population estimates are considered unreliable at lower geographic levels. This year, like last, the Australian Bureau of Statistics has released revised population figures for previous years. The revisions are reflected in this report and hence previous years' population figures may vary. As a result, average alcohol consumption figures for previous years may have also been affected.

Where population changes are cited for regional areas, they are based on the Australian Bureau of Statistics' total estimated drinking-age residential population for those regions.

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¹ Northern Territory Balance is defined as the rest of the Northern Territory after the urban centres (i.e. Darwin, Palmerston, Alice Springs, Katherine, Tennant Creek and Nhulunbuy) have been removed.

Summary

Estimated per capita consumption of alcohol in the Northern Territory has decreased to 11.6 litres per person in the 2017 calendar year. This is the lowest value in estimated consumption recorded for the Northern Territory in the period 2010 to 2017. The latest value continues the decreasing trend in estimated consumption seen in the Northern Territory since 2010.

Estimated per capita consumption in 2017 was 3% less than in 2016 and 14% less than in 2010.

Wholesale alcohol supply (litres pure alcohol content) in the Northern Territory in 2017 remained relatively steady while the estimated drinking-age population increased by 3%.

Wholesale alcohol supply (litres pure alcohol content) in Darwin in 2017 was 3% less than in 2016 while the estimated drinking-age population increased by 1%.

Wholesale alcohol supply (litres pure alcohol content) in Palmerston in 2017 was 3% less than in 2016 while the estimated drinking-age population increased by 2%.

Wholesale alcohol supply (litres pure alcohol content) in Alice Springs in 2017 was 8% more than in 2016 while the estimated drinking-age population remained relatively steady.

Wholesale alcohol supply (litres pure alcohol content) in Katherine in 2017 was 2% less than in 2016 while the estimated drinking-age population increased by 1%.

Wholesale alcohol supply (litres pure alcohol content) in Tennant Creek in 2017 was 4% more than in 2016 while the estimated drinking-age population decreased by 1%.

Wholesale alcohol supply (litres pure alcohol content) in Nhulunbuy in 2017 was 5% more than in 2016 while the estimated drinking-age population remained relatively steady.

Wholesale alcohol supply (litres pure alcohol content) in the Northern Territory Balance in 2017 was 1% more than in 2016 while the estimated drinking-age residential population increased by 1%.

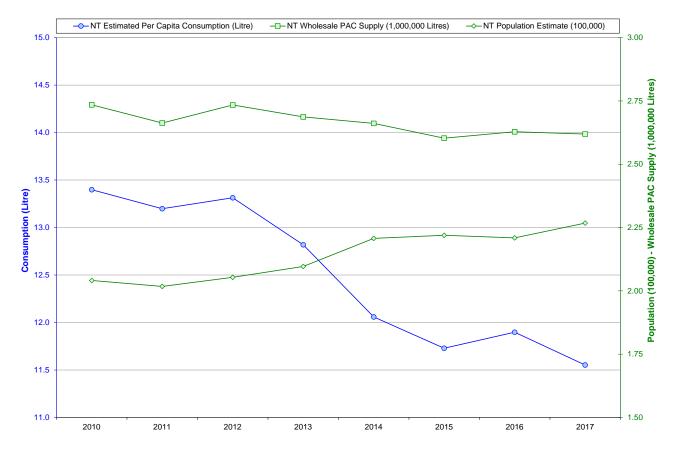

In 2017, the Northern Territory estimated per capita consumption of alcohol decreased by 3%, from 11.9 litres per person to 11.55 litres per person.

Between 2010 and 2017, estimated per capita consumption of alcohol in the Northern Territory has shown a decreasing trend.

In 2017, the total wholesale PAC supply remained relatively steady. Total spirits decreased by 2%, while total beer increased by 1% and total wine remained relatively steady.

Between 2010 and 2017, the total wholesale PAC supply exhibited a decreasing trend of about 1% per year. Total spirits and total beer exhibited a decreasing trend of about 1% per year. Total cider increased by 60% while total wine decreased by 9% over the period.

Figure 2: Wholesale PAC Supply - Northern Territory

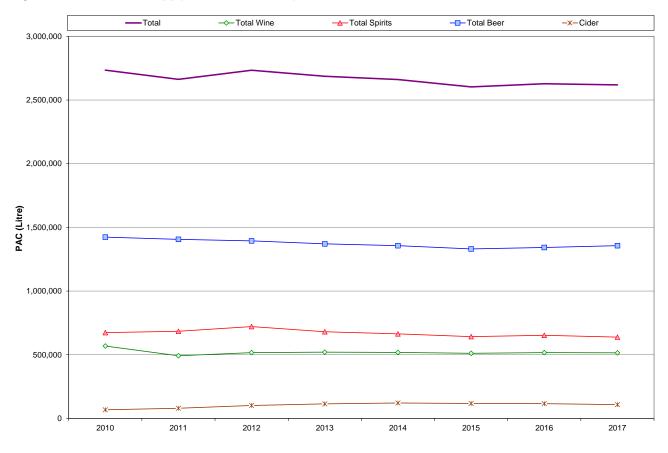

In 2017, the total supply of wine remained relatively steady. Cask wine decreased by 9% and fortified wine decreased by 8%, while bottled wine increased by 2%.

Figure 3: Wholesale PAC Supply Wine - Northern Territory

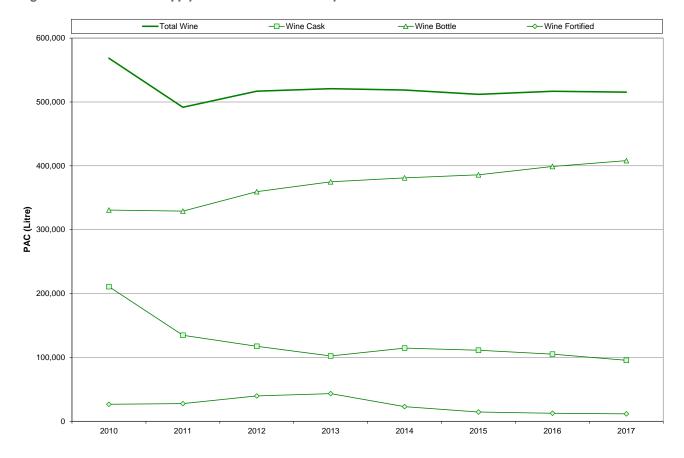

Figure 4: Wholesale PAC Supply Spirits - Northern Territory

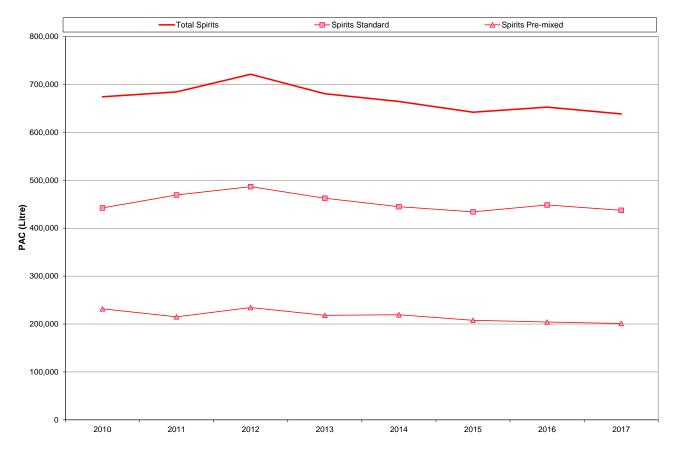

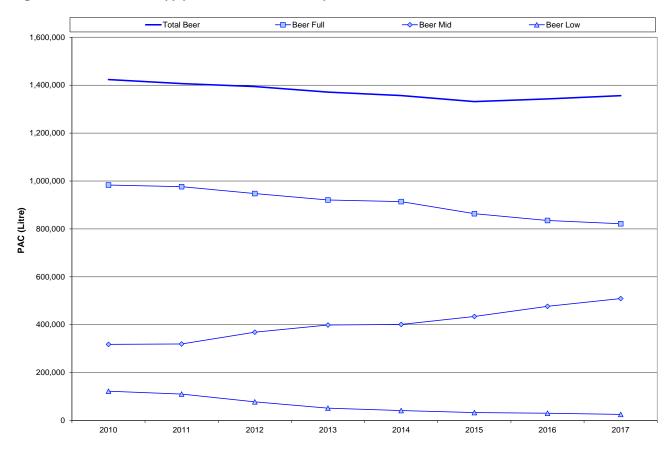

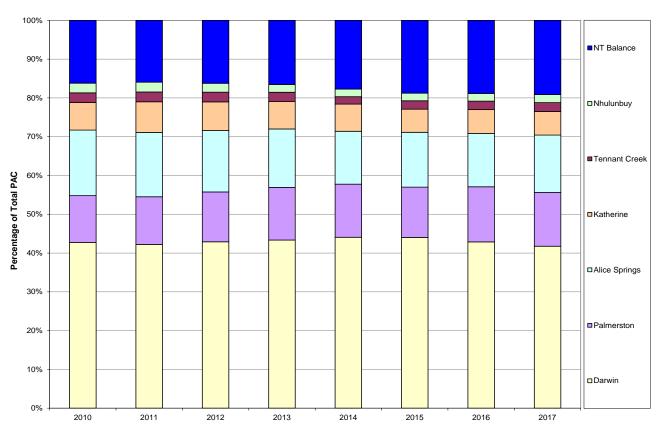

In 2017, Darwin and Palmerston accounted for 56% of the Northern Territory wholesale PAC supply. Alice Springs accounted for 15% and Northern Territory Balance accounted for 19%. The remaining 10% was supplied to Katherine, Tennant Creek and Nhulunbuy.

Between 2010 and 2017, the percentage of total supply to Palmerston and Northern Territory Balance showed an increasing trend, while the percentage of total supply to Alice Springs and Katherine showed a decreasing trend.

Figure 6: Wholesale PAC Supply - Darwin

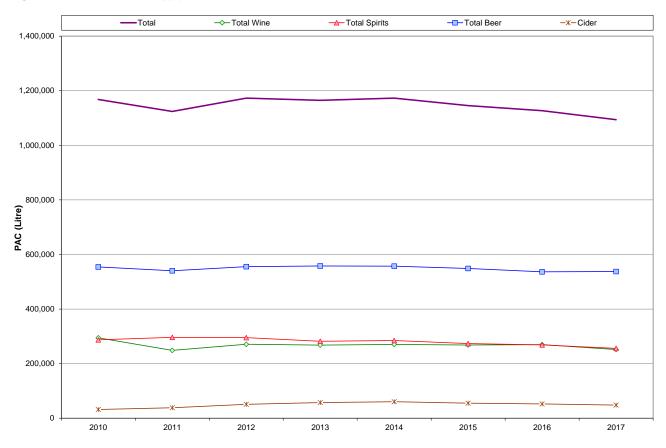

Figure 7: Wholesale PAC Supply Wine - Darwin

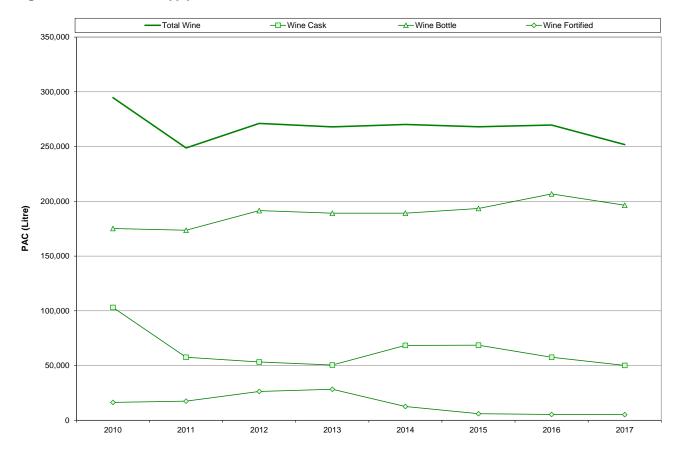

Figure 8: Wholesale PAC Supply Spirits - Darwin

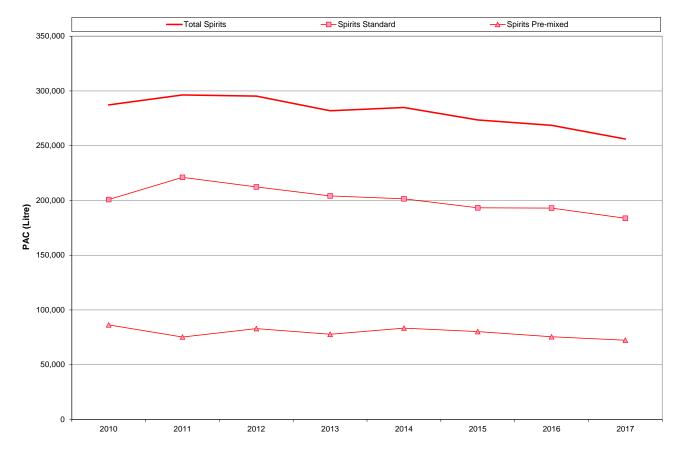

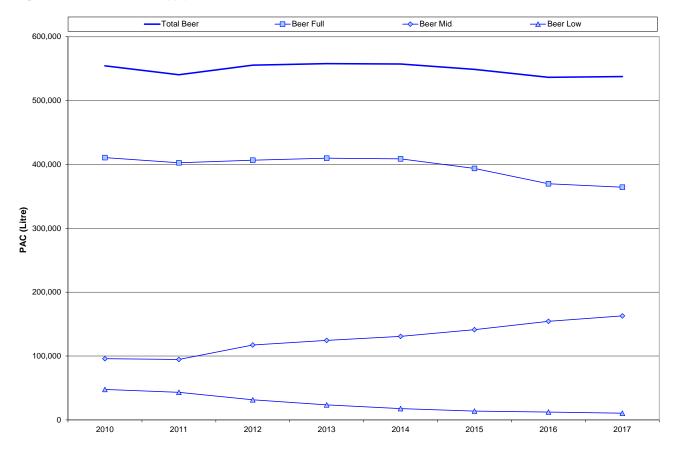

Figure 10: Wholesale PAC Supply - Palmerston

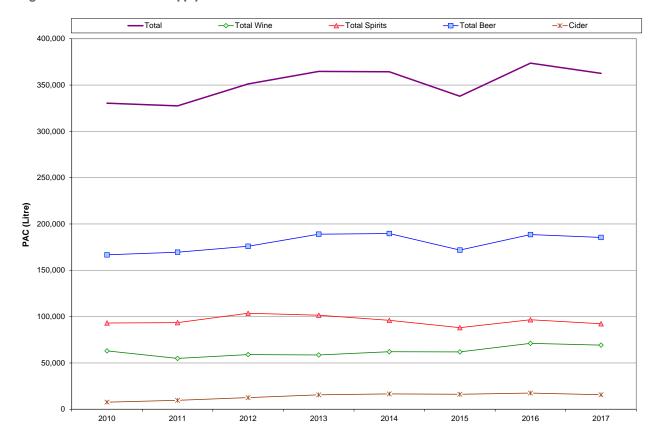

Figure 11: Wholesale PAC Supply Wine - Palmerston

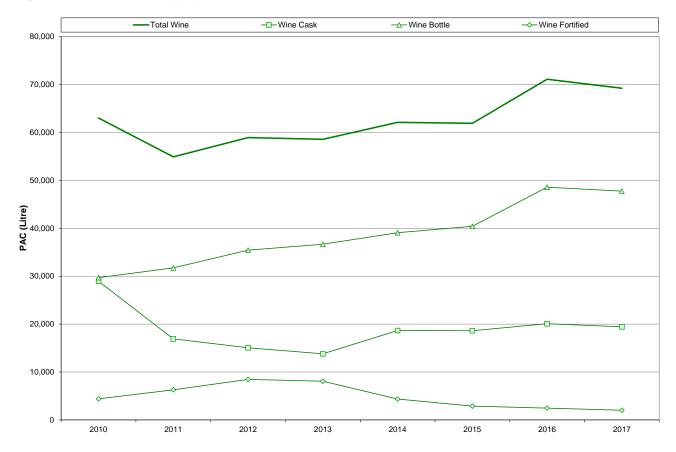

Figure 12: Wholesale PAC Supply Spirits - Palmerston

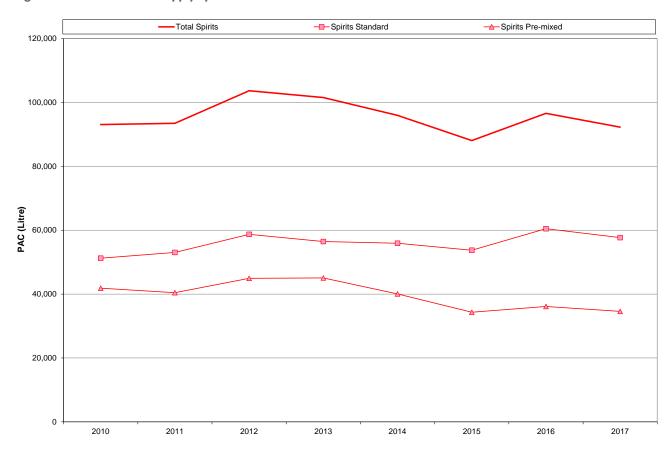

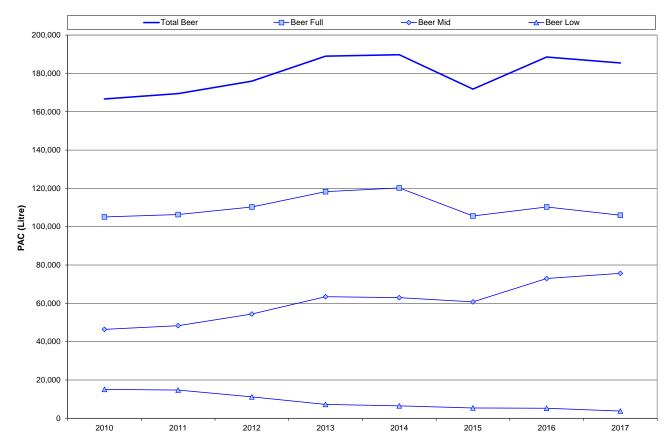

Figure 14: Wholesale PAC Supply - Alice Springs

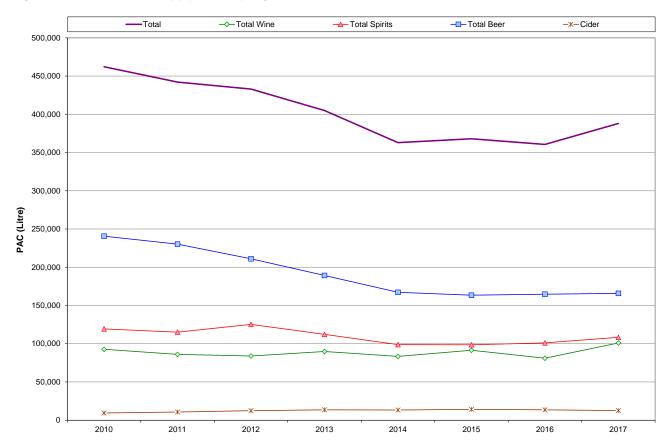

Figure 15: Wholesale PAC Supply Wine - Alice Springs

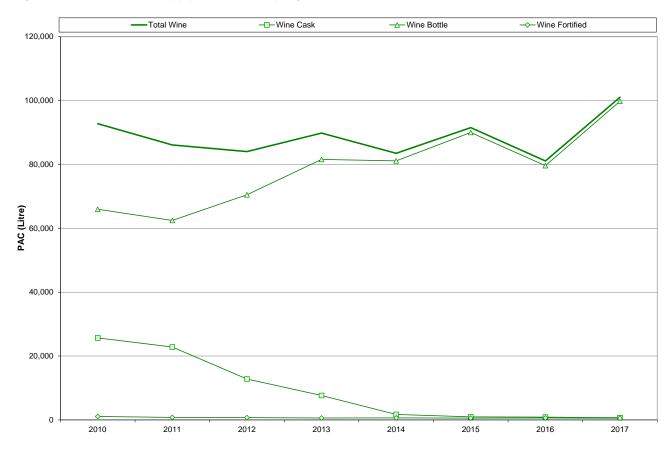

Figure 16: Wholesale PAC Supply Spirits - Alice Springs

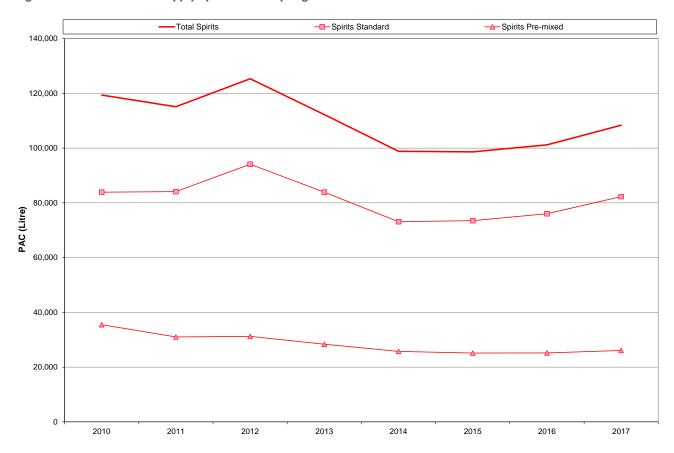

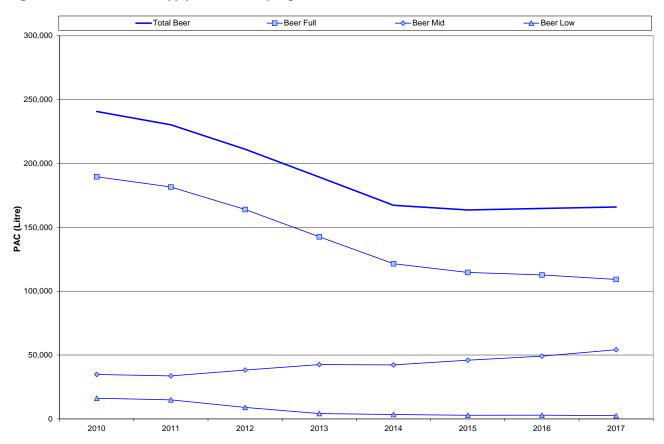

Figure 18: Wholesale PAC Supply - Katherine

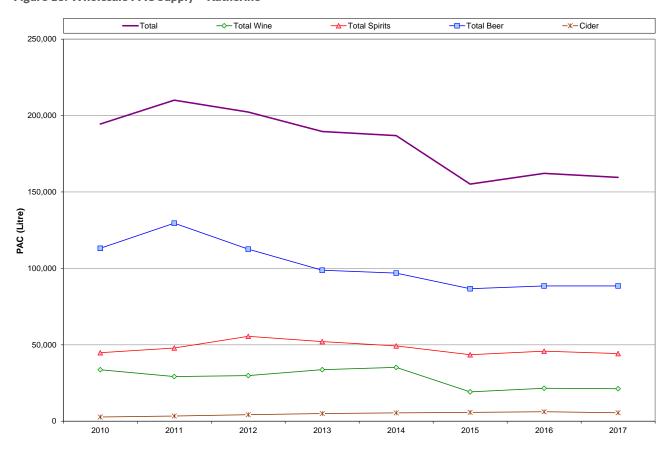

Figure 19: Wholesale PAC Supply Wine - Katherine

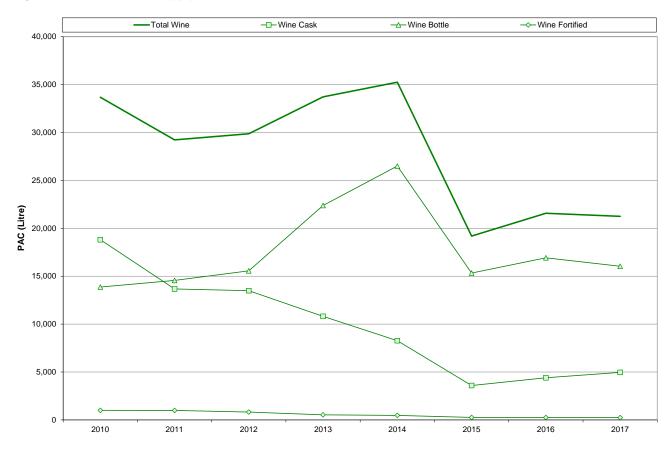

Figure 20: Wholesale PAC Supply Wine - Katherine

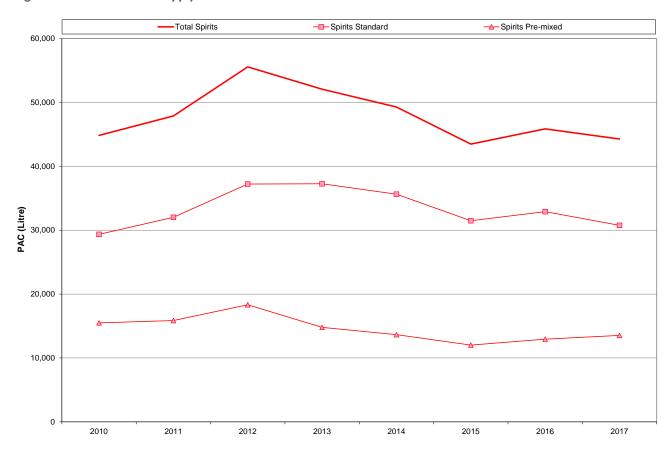

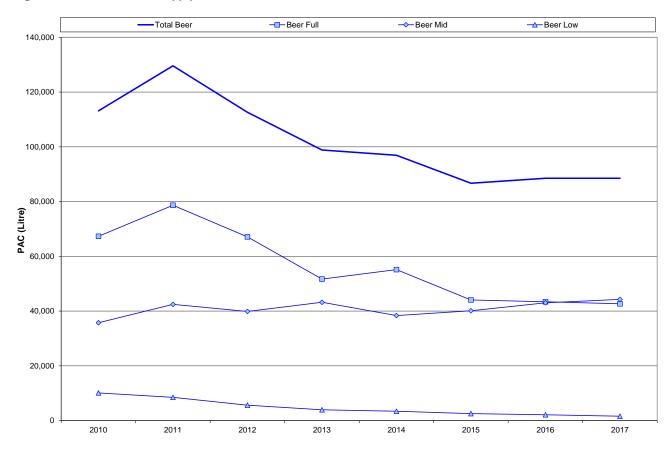

Figure 22: Wholesale PAC Supply - Tennant Creek

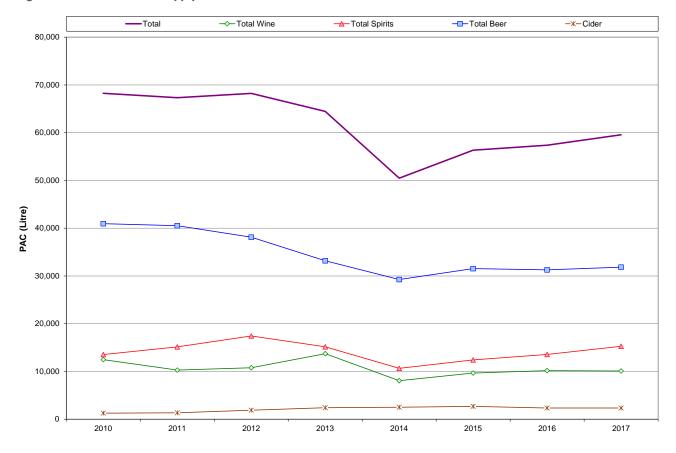

Figure 23: Wholesale PAC Supply Wine - Tennant Creek

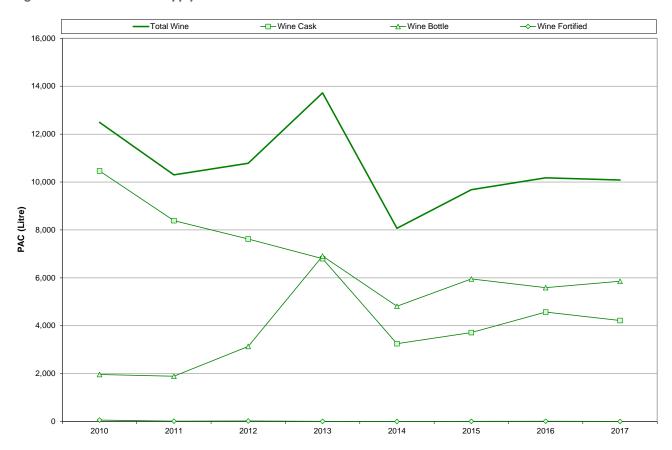

Figure 24: Wholesale PAC Supply Spirits - Tennant Creek

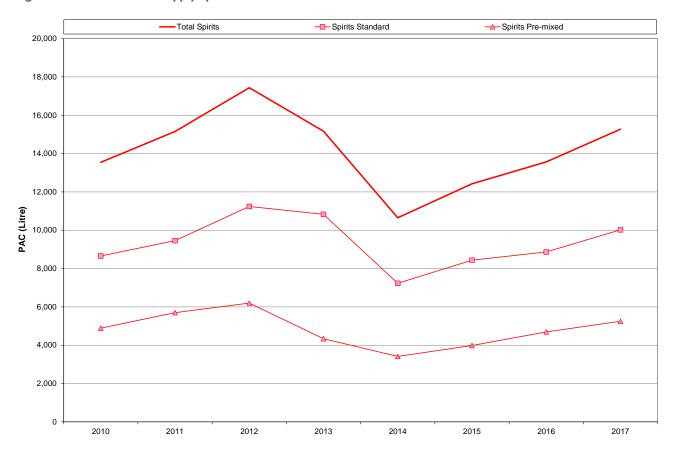

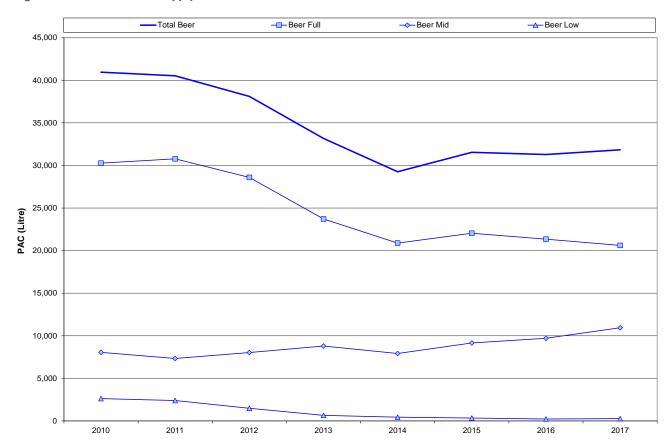

Figure 26: Wholesale PAC Supply - Nhulunbuy

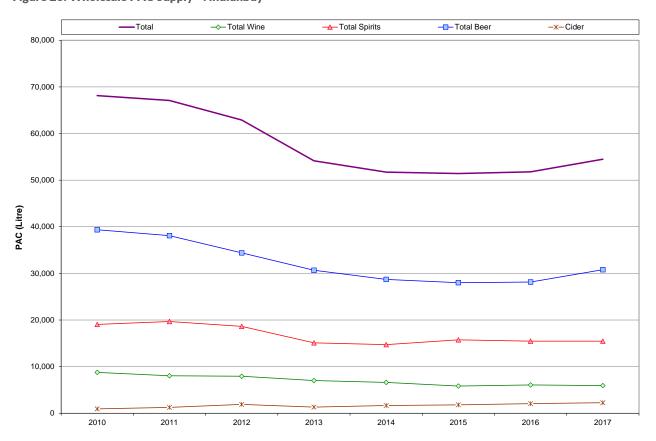

Figure 27: Wholesale PAC Supply Wine - Nhulunbuy

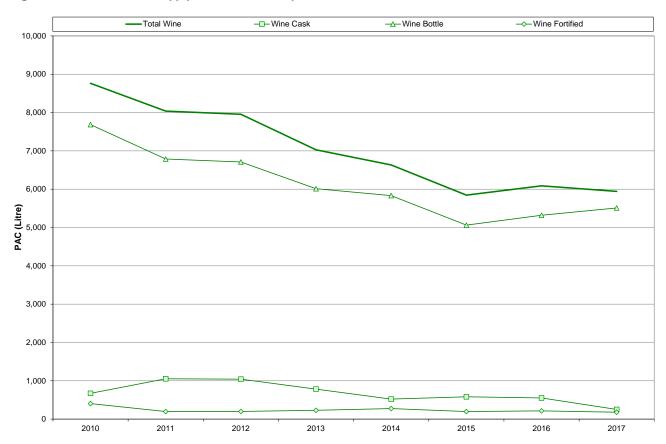

Figure 28: Wholesale PAC Supply Spirits - Nhulunbuy

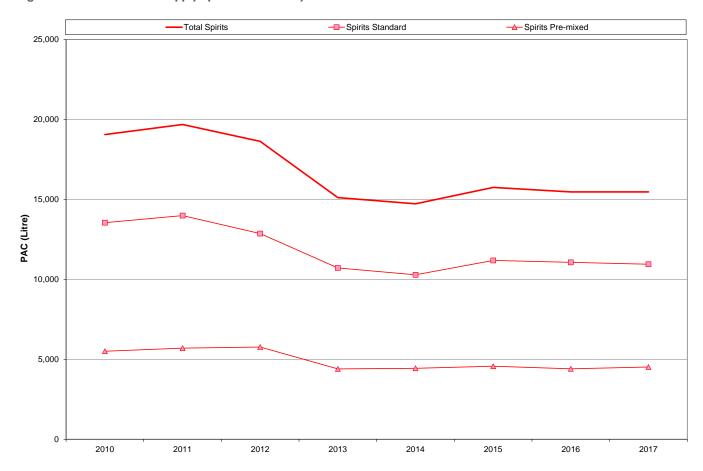

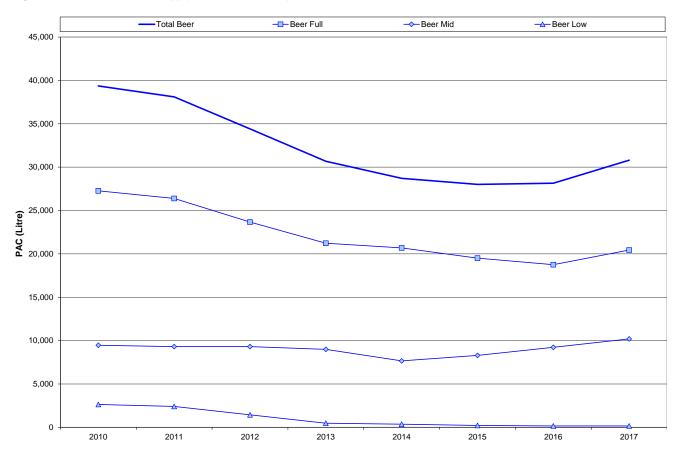

Figure 30: Wholesale PAC Supply - Northern Territory Balance

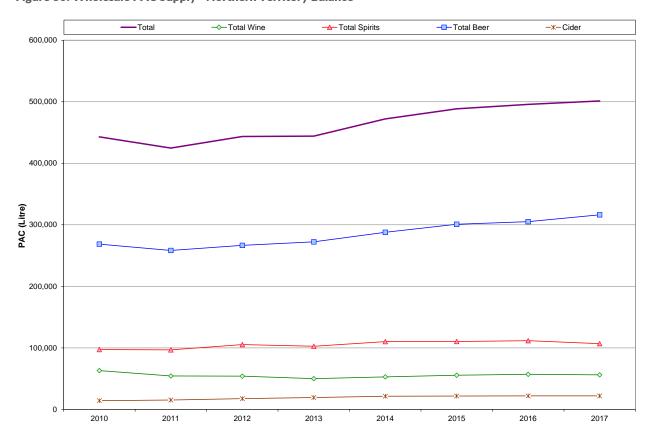

Figure 31: Wholesale PAC Supply Wine - Northern Territory Balance

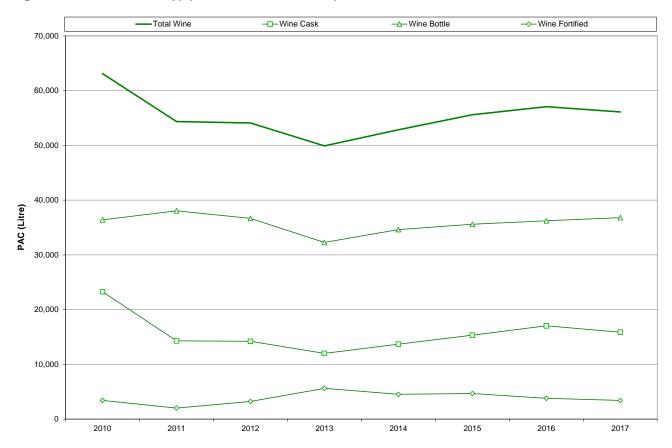

Figure 32: Wholesale PAC Supply Spirits - Northern Territory Balance

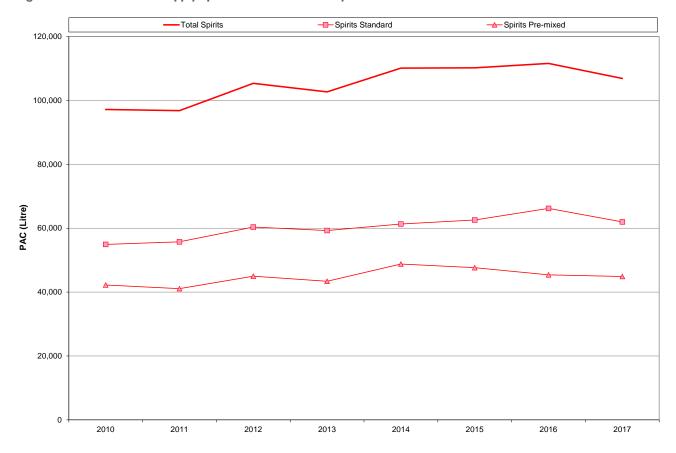

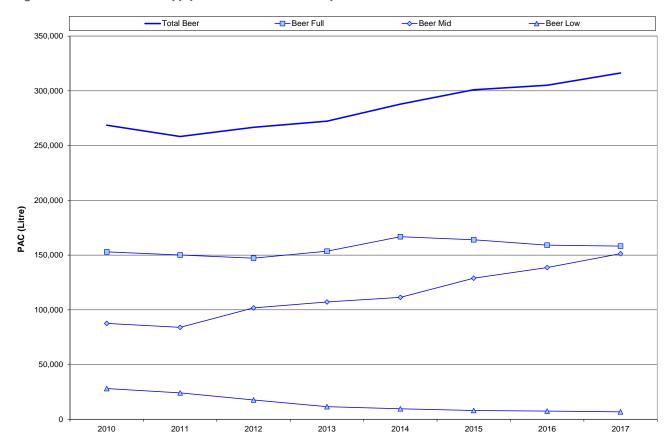
